

Welcome to the course registration doc for the EBM Academy at AAHS. As you may know, each Academy at AAHS is essentially a Career and Technical Education (CTE)focused school-within-a-school.

Students who attend an Academy choose a slate of courses - like declaring a major in college.

Being a part of an Academy is selective. While any student may fill out this course registration sheet, only 60 seats are available per grade level. Student membership in the Academies at AAHS is granted through a rigorous process including the timely completion of an interest form, an in-person interview, and ongoing performance reviews during the school year.

If you are a person who wants to be one of the next generation of entrepreneurs, businesspeople, and marketers, the EBM Academy is for you. In EBM, you will gain valuable work experience and challenge yourself to earn industry certificates all while you are still in high school.
