

**Foothills Elementary School
Student Fee Schedule 2022-23**

Student Transportation

20Ride Pass	Neighborhood School Transportation	\$50 per student, not to exceed \$200 per family per semester	Provide daily school bus transportation to and from school for an individual transportation eligible student for a single semester	Students are not permitted to access a school bus for transportation to/from school. Students may purchase single-ride tickets as an alternative
20Ride Pass	In-District Choice Transportation	\$60 per student, not to exceed \$240 per family per semester	Provide daily school bus transportation to and from school for an individual transportation eligible student for a single semester	Students are not permitted to access a school bus for transportation to/from school. Students may purchase single-ride tickets as an alternative
20Ride Pass	Out-of-District Choice Transportation	\$70 per student, not to exceed \$280 per family per semester	Provide daily school bus transportation to and from school for an individual transportation eligible student for a single semester	Students are not permitted to access a school bus for transportation to/from school. Students may purchase single-ride tickets as an alternative
20Ride Pass	Any Combination of Above	Not to exceed \$280 per family per semester	Recognize a single family may have students enrolled in neighborhood and choice schools	Students are not permitted to access a school bus for transportation to/from school. Students may purchase single-ride tickets as an alternative

Semester ride passes may be purchased with a credit/debit card using the Infinite Campus parent portal, or by cash or check at the transportation center or Education and Administration Center. 20Ride passes must be purchased prior to riding a bus. Semester passes are nonrefundable, either in part or in whole. For infrequent riders, single-ride tickets are also available as an alternative (See below).

20Ride Booklet	Infrequent use of Transportation	\$20 per booklet	Provide an alternative to the semester pass for infrequent eligible riders. Each booklet contains 20 single-ride tickets. Booklets do not expire and are transferable	Students are not permitted to access a school bus for transportation to/from school. Students may purchase a semester unlimited ride pass as an alternative

Single ride booklets are sold in units of 20, are transferable, and do not expire. Booklets must be purchased in person at the school, transportation center, or Education and Administration Center. A single one-way ride requires one ticket. Booklets must be purchased prior to riding.

Classroom Fee	Classroom supplies	Not to exceed \$35 per year	To cover a portion of the cost of supplies that are expendable and consumable and/or items the school will retain after the class. This fee replaces school supply lists and parent purchased school supplies. Check with school website for school specific fees	The required items and/or materials or a comparable alternative will be provided. Students will not be excluded from the class or classroom activities if the fee is unpaid.
Classroom Fee	Consumable material	Not to exceed \$40 per year See school website for applicability	To cover actual cost of consumable material used by the student in the classroom and/or are items students will retain after the class. Examples include readers, online subscriptions, t-shirts, communication folders workbooks, planners, party supplies, etc.	Required items/materials or a comparable alternative will be provided. Students will not be excluded from classroom activities if the fee is unpaid
Classroom Fee	Take Flight Consumable material	Not to exceed \$65 per year	To cover a portion of the cost of consumable material for <i>Take Flight</i> academic support	Required items/materials or a comparable alternative will be provided. Students will not be excluded from classroom activities if the fee is unpaid
Course Fee	Field Trip Fee	Varies by field trip – See school website or field trip sponsor	To cover cost or a portion of the cost of admission and transportation. Fee is relative to cost of field trip	A comparable alternative may be provided. With prior arrangement, a student who desires to participate in class field trip will not be excluded if the fee is unpaid
User Fee	District issued mobile device	\$50 per school year	To offset a portion of the cost of devices and to insure against accidental damage	Student will not be issued a personal mobile technology device

Beginning in 2015-16, a student fee schedule specific to each school shall be posted to the school website in a prescribed location and shall be updated annually. Fees associated with a specific course shall also be included with the course description in the school's Course Guide. Only fees referenced and approved in procedure JQ-R may be levied.
