

Our Community

Academy School District has approximately 26,000 students enrolled in 25 elementary schools, 11 middle schools, and 10 high schools in the northern portion of Colorado Springs.

Our School

Pine Creek High School is a four-year public high school and School of Innovation and Learning through Technology. Our student population is 1912 students in grades 9-12. We have 161 faculty and staff members. We offer highly competitive academic programs, championship athletic teams, and award-winning arts, music and business programs. We continually focus on social and emotional intelligence, and a positive and inclusive school spirit. Students graduate from PCHS as critical, creative and ethical thinkers. Graduates are prepared to pursue their personal and professional interests after high school.

The class of 2024 includes 427 seniors.

Academic Requirements

Courses are taught in block schedule composed of eight 90-minute class periods. A minimum of 50 credits are required for graduation. (1 credit = 1 semester).

Curriculum

PCHS offers 25 AP courses and 20 honors courses for grades 9-12. There is no limit to the number of AP or honors courses a student can enroll in per semester. In addition, students may access concurrent and dual enrollment through Pikes Peak State College and the University of Colorado at Colorado Springs, as well as over a dozen Career and Technical Education pathways throughout the district.

Grade Point Averages

All courses are used to compile an official grade point average. Grades earned in approved AP, CE/dual enrollment, and honors courses are weighted and include one extra point per credit for that course based on a 4-point scale. Weighted courses are noted with an asterisk on the official transcript.

Grading System

Courses which receive a letter grade are calculated into the GPA. Advanced Placement (AP) and Honors (H) courses receive the same weighted grades. Class rank and cumulative GPA are computed in January and June.

A = 90-100, B = 80-89, C = 70-79, D = 60-69, F = 59-Below, NC = No Credit, I = Incomplete, WF = Withdraw Fail, P = Passing

Advanced Placement: In 2023, 604 students successfully completed 1009 exams with 74% scoring a passing score of 3 or higher.

The Class of 2023 had 373 graduates.

The Valedictorian earned a 4.75 GPA. 31% of the class graduated with a 4.0 GPA or higher.

Post High School Placement:

71% matriculated to four-year schools. 17% matriculated to two-year schools. 25% of the Class of 2024 were awarded one or more scholarships.
